Phishing Best Practices



Best Practices

- Carefully check the URL before clicking on it.
- Do not click on shortened URLs without verifying by expanding them.
- Never panic on seeing messages which show urgency and validate its genuineness.
- Do not trust promotional offers which look “too good to be true”.
- Do not hesitate to report to Law Enforcement Agencies, if you become a victim of phishing.
- Verify the email ids in emails addressed to generic recipients.
- Look for typing errors (eg., Acc0unt, email, dep0sit, passw0rd)
- Look for poor grammar and unprofessional language (“Do yu kare about yurself?”)
